


Our Why

According to recent data, 26% of Houstonians identify the economy as the most significant challenge facing the region. Our goal is to alleviate these concerns by offering free financial counseling and services to the community, thereby creating opportunities for improvement and support.

Forty-three percent of Houstonians feel they would struggle with a \$400 emergency expense. Partner organizations are hosting events to provide financial counseling, helping the community manage unforeseen situations. Promoting financial wellness is crucial for achieving and maintaining financial prosperity.

Approximately 8% of Houston's population is unbanked, while an additional 17% is classified as underbanked. Among our partners are banking institutions that offer safe and affordable BankOn Certified accounts to address these financial accessibility issues.

One out of every four households in the Houston area utilizes alternative financial services, which collectively incur over \$3 billion in fees for Americans annually. Houston Money Week provides an opportunity for individuals to develop better financial habits to steer clear of these costly alternatives.




